The \$2.4M program will support Ultimate Recipients to install a notional target of 90 Level 2 chargers and 14 Fast Chargers in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba for commercial and public fleets.

The EV Fleet Charging Program is a third-party delivery stream of the Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program and SCRAP-IT[®] thanks Natural Resources Canada for the opportunity to deliver this important initiative.
